Dear Shri Jain,

Sub: Regularization of railway accommodation in favour of wards of railway employees employed under LARSGESS

As you are aware that the wards of railway employees employed on compassionate ground on account of medical de-categorization or immature death of the employee, are regularized railway accommodation, originally allotted to his/her father as per extant rules.

The wards of railway employees are also been appointed under LARSGESS, where too, the employee retired at the time of recruitment of his/her ward. Virtually, appointment under LARSGESS is almost comparable to appointment on compassionate ground, however, the facility of regularization of railway accommodation, in possession of father/mother of the ward, as the case may be, is not being extended in these cases. This is causing undue hardship to the families of the employees who seek voluntary retirement under LARSGESS.

I would, therefore, request you to look into this issue and necessary instructions may be issued to all zonal railways to regularize railway accommodation, in possession of railway employee, in favour of their wards appointed under LARSGESS after retirement of the employee concerned so that their families are not subjected to any hardship.

An early action in the matter shall be highly appreciated.
