Sub: Exemption from the provisions of Railways Act, 1989 in respect of Track  
Machine staff

Attention is invited to Board's letter of even number dated 09.09.2009 granting temporary exemption for 3 years i.e. up to 08.09.2012 from the provisions of Railways Act, 1989 for introducing three weeks' roster at a stretch followed by continuous rest of one week at the Headquarters in respect of the staff operating track machines.

The matter has been examined in consultation with Ministry of Labour & Employment and it has been agreed to grant exemption for a further period of three years w.e.f.09.09.2012 till September, 2015 with the same condition that the three weeks' work at a stretch will include the journey period utilized by the workman in respect of journey conducted by him from the duty point to his Headquarters followed by one week rest.






