

Ref: WP No. 8948 of 2013 In the matter of DMRKS


The above referred writ petition came up for hearing today together with the WPMPs. In fact the petitioner today moved another MP seeking for a relief to set aside the allotment of symbols to the respondent unions 6 and 7 i.e. flag and engine. Sri S.R. Ashok, Sr.Counsel appeared on our behalf and opposed the reliefs sought for by the petitioner. The Hon'ble Court is not inclined to grant the relief of setting aside the order allocating the symbols and also opined that the matter is subject to interpretation at the time of hearing after the filing of the counter.

However, the Hon'ble Court to ensure level playing field, directed the railways to implement Clause 32 of the Modalities for Secret Ballot Elections. The exact wording of the order would be informed to you on obtaining the copy of the same and efforts are being made to obtain the copies at the earliest point of time.
