Ref:- Your letter no. (i) AIRF/PNM/4/2011 (154) dated 28-11-2013; and
(ii) AIRF/364 (VI CPC) (35) dated 06-02-2014.

Please connect your letters *ibid*. The issue of Pharmacists raised in your letter dated 28-11-2013 has been examined and it is stated that recommendations of Fast Track Committee as advised by Ministry of Finance vide their OM dated 18-11-2009 have been fully implemented on Railways/PUs etc. vide Board's letter No. PC-VI/2009/1/RSRP/10 dated 30-03-2010. Subsequently, the word 'promotion' used in the second sentence of para 3 of Board's letter *ibid* has been replaced by the word 'placement' vide Board's letter of even number dated 05-08-2010. Further, as per recommendation of Cadre Restructuring Committee as accepted by Board/MR, cadre restructuring orders for certain Group 'C' categories including Pharmacists have been issued vide Board's letter no. PC-III/2013/CRC/4 dated 08-10-2013.

Further, the issue of non-considering MACP while calculating financial implications for cadre restructuring, raised vide your letter AIRF/364 (VI CPC) (35) dated 06-02-2014 has also been examined and it is stated that the guidelines for calculation of financial implications as received from Ministry of Finance do not mention anything about MACP based upgradations not being counted for matching surrender. Guidelines for calculation of financial implications received from Ministry of Finance vide their OM dated 02-12-2009, have been circulated to Railways vide item 12 of Board's cadre restructuring orders dated 08-10-2013.
