**Record note of discussions held by AM (PU) with Federation (AIRF) on 12.06.13 regarding PNM/AIRF Item No. 54/2012 – Modifications of RITES Incentive Scheme – Approval of Railway Board.**

It was informed that Board's approval has already been communicated to the Railway.

General Secretary/AIRF, however, mentioned that sanctioned posts in the Wagon Workshop, Rayanapadu of South Central Railway are not being filled up resulting in a shortage of around 300 staff. It was also mentioned that the matter has been raised by the Federation's Affiliate Union on South Central Railway but the issue is not resolved. Hence, the matter is being raised at Board's level. The Federation insisted for filling of vacancies because only sanctioning of post will not provide any relief to staff.

The official side stated that since the matter is entirely within the purview of the GM of the Railway, he would be requested to expedite action in filling up of the vacancies.
