

**MEMORANDUM SUBMITTED TO SHRI ANURAG,  
DIVISIONAL RAILWAY MANAGER,  
SOUTH CENTRAL RAILWAY,  
VIJAYAWADA ON 18th JULY, 2012.**

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As per the clarion call given by the All India Railwaymen's Federation, the South Central Railway Mazdoor Union, Vijayawada Division held a massive demonstration to protest against inordinate delay in finalization of just reasonable demands and also non implementation of agreed issues.

1. **ALLOTMENT OF `4800 GRADE PAY TO SUPERVISORS:-** The Sixth Pay commission while replacing the existing system of Scale with that of Grade Pay has done lot of injustice to the Supervisors of all the categories. The Commission has recommended merger of scale of pay of `7450-11500 and `6500-10500 to that of `4600 Grade Pay. In certain categories it has recommended higher grade of Rs.4800/- and above. Thus lot of injustice has done to the supervisors in not allotting the Grade Pay of Rs.4800/- The Union therefore demands allotment of Grade Pay of Rs.4800/- to all the supervisors who were in the scale of pay of Rs.7450-11500.
2. **MERGER OF TECHNICIANS GRADE I AND GRADE II:-** At present the Technicians Grade II were given the Grade pay of Rs.2400/- and that of Technicians Grade I to that of Rs.2800/- . The Union demands merger of both Technicians Grade II and Technicians Grade I to that of Grade pay of Rs.2800/-
3. **FILLING UP OF THE VACANCIES OF TECHNICIANS GRADE III:-** There are large number of vacancies in the category of Technician Grade II which are required to be filled in by promotion of existing Helpers under promotional quota and by Railway Recruitment Board under Direct Recruitment Quota. As the vacancies were kept unfilled, the Union demands filling up of all the vacancies of Tech. Grade III by promotion of existing Helpers as one time exemption.
4. **UPGRADATION OF APEX GROUP `C` POSTS TO GROUP `B`:-** The issue of upgradation of 15% of Apex Group `C` posts to Group `B` was pending with the Railway Board for more than a decade. Even though it was agreed in the various fora for upgradation of Apex Group `C` posts to Group `B` posts, it has not been implemented so far. The Union demands immediate upgradation of 15% of Apex Group `C` posts to Group `B`.
5. **CREATION OF POSTS:-** Even though more number of trains have been introduced, the posts required for maintenance of rolling stock, Wagons, Engines in the C&W Departments, Loco / Diesel Sheds, S&T Departments, Electrical Loco Sheds, Engineering Departments have not been created. The Union demands creation of additional posts without insisting on matching surrender.
6. **CADRE RESTRUCTURING:-** The cadre restructuring committee has agreed in principle the restructuring of the cadre in the Artisan cadre, Technical Supervisors and an agreement was reached for the same. The Union demands immediate implementation of the agreed %age without insisting on matching surrender of posts.

In addition to the above, the Union demands allotment of MACPS as per the cadre hierarchy instead of Grade Pay hierarchy, and rectifying the various anomalies pointed out in implementation of Sixth Pay Commission.

We request you to take necessary immediate action in respect of items pertaining at your level and forward the memorandum to the General Manager & Chairman Railway Board for immediate action.
